## The Financial Implications of Buying 1 Jackson Close, Elmbridge Village, Cranleigh, Surrey, GU6 8TQ

Set out below are worked examples of the financial implications of buying the above property. Created on 20/8/2024.

This illustration is not a forecast and, like any other investment, the value of properties in the village could go down as well as up.

#### **EXAMPLE 1: TYPICAL ANNUAL COSTS**

This first example deals with the potential annual costs of buying a retirement property. It excludes:

- The cost of any **mortgage** you may have, and;
- The **personal monthly bills** for which you would be liable, such as council tax, electricity, gas, water, telephone rates and charges, (if applicable), contents insurance, television licence, broadband / satellite / cable subscriptions and any other bills.

The costs shown are based upon the purchase cost and service charge costs for single or double occupancy of a 2 bedroom Bungalow, address 1 Jackson Close, Elmbridge Village, Cranleigh, Surrey, GU6 8TQ, purchased for **£485,000 (Four Hundred and Eighty-Five Thousand Pounds)**.

As a leasehold owner, you will be responsible for the following costs, which are applicable from: Apr 2024 to Mar 2025 and annually thereafter.

## EXAMPLE 2: A SALE (Otherwise known as assignment) of your property

This second example deals with some of the one-off costs if you were to sell (otherwise known as to "assignâ€) your property. It excludes:

- Any outstanding ground rent or service charge that you owe;
- Any mortgage costs, including the cost of paying off (sometimes referred to as redeeming) your mortgage;
- The costs of any solicitor, conveyancer or legal adviser you appoint to deal with the sale/assignment;
- Any estate agents fees; (Inclusive if using Elmbridge Village Management Limited re-sales service)
- Any tax which you may have to pay, including stamp duty;
- Any costs of moving;
- The cost of ensuring the property is in good decorative order prior to the resale.

# The assignment fee, which is payable to the landlord, Elmbridge Village Management Limited, provides a return on the original investment in developing the communal facilities in the Village. It does not contribute towards the costs of any services that are provided or to a sinking fund and accordingly is not held in trust for residents

If you purchase the property for £485,000 and in the future sell/assign it for the sale prices below, examples of the corresponding assignment fees incurred on the sale/assignment of the property are indicated underneath the sale prices:-

The proportion of the sales price payable changes: 5% (1st year), 10% (2nd year) or 12.5% (after year 2) of the sales price when resold.

The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	5% of the sale price	£24,978 Payable when you sell

The Assignment Fee if paid on sale	5% of the sale price	£23,522 Payable when you sell
