The Financial Implications of Buying 39 Priory Court, Priory Road, Abbotskerswell, Newton Abbot, Devon, TQ12 5PP

Set out below are worked examples of the financial implications of buying the above property. Created on 01/12/2025.

EXAMPLE 1: TYPICAL ANNUAL COSTS

This first example deals with the annual costs of buying a retirement property. It excludes:

- The cost of any mortgage you may have, and;
- -The personal monthly bills for which you would be liable, such as council tax, electricity, gas, water, telephone rates and charges, (if applicable), contents insurance, television licence, broadband / satellite / cable subscriptions and any other bills.

The costs shown are based upon the purchase cost and service charge costs for single or double occupancy of a 2 bedroom Cottage, 39 Priory Court, Priory Road, Abbotskerswell, Newton Abbot, Devon, TQ12 5PP, purchased for £380,000.00 Three Hundred and Eighty Thousand Pounds.

As a leasehold owner, you will be responsible for the following costs, which are applicable from: 01/05/2025 to 31/04/2025 and annually thereafter.

EXAMPLE 2: A SALE (Otherwise known as assignment) of your property

This second example deals with some of the one-off costs if you were to sell (otherwise known as to assign) your property. It excludes:

- Any outstanding ground rent or service charge that you owe;
- Any mortgage costs, including the cost of paying off (sometimes referred to as redeeming) your mortgage;
- The costs of any **solicitor**, conveyancer or legal advisor you appoint to deal with the sale/assignment;
- Any **estate agent fees**; (Inclusive if using RV Property Holdings Ltd re-sales service)
- Any tax which you may have to pay, including stamp duty;
- Any costs of moving
- The cost of ensuring the property is in good decorative order prior to the resale.

The assignment fee, which is payable to the landlord, RV Property Holdings Ltd, provides a return on the original investment in developing the communal facilities in the Village. It does not contribute towards the costs of any services that are provided or to a sinking fund and accordingly is not held in trust for its residents.

If you purchase the property for £380,000.00 and in the future sell/assign it for the sale prices below, examples of the corresponding assignment fees incurred on the sale/assignment of the property are indicated underneath the sale prices:-

The proportion of the sales price payable changes: it is 1.5% Fixed fee, does not change over time.
